

# Study Check Inholland

You will get acquainted with lecturers and/or students from the degree programme. We hope you get a good impression of the match between you and the degree programme. You will receive the final study choice recommendation from our Central Student Administration via email. Which steps you must take after completing the Study Check is explained below.



## Study Check completed: you and the degree programme are a match

If you are a match (possibly with points requiring attention), you can start the degree programme in September.



## Study Check completed: you and the degree programme are not a match

If you and the degree programme are not a match, you will likely be disappointed. Just remember that the Study Check is intended to make you aware of your study choice before you start a degree programme, to ensure your choice is in line with your skills, wishes and expectations. If you are not a match, there are two possibilities:

### 1. You are not a match and you registered before 1 May

The study choice recommendation you received is not binding. You can start the degree programme of your choice in September. We do, however, recommend you consider your choice carefully and why you are not a match.

### 2. You are not a match and you registered after 1 May

In many cases, the study choice recommendation you received will be binding. Go to [inholland.nl/studiekeuzecheck](https://inholland.nl/studiekeuzecheck) to find out more about the conditions. This means that you cannot start the degree programme of your choice. During the Study Check, the lecturer explained why you were not a match.

Before you can start the degree programme, you must first meet all of the enrolment requirements. An up-to-date overview of the enrolment requirements that apply to you can be found in Selfservice ([studentportal.inholland.nl](https://studentportal.inholland.nl)) and in the Inholland MyStart app. Make sure you meet all of the applicable conditions as soon as possible.
