Given that this event is international, with participants from around the world, the primary language is English. DigiQuest Amsterdam's workshops, presentations, and talk shows are all in English. However, most of the organization's staff and partners also speak Dutch.

Should I bring food and drinks myself?

We will provide food and drinks free of charge. Coffee, tea, water, juices, and snacks are served at arrival and during the day. You'll get vegetarian sandwiches for lunch and will conclude the day with snacks and non-alcoholic drinks. Do you have allergies or specific preferences? When will the event take place?

DigiQuest Amsterdam will take place **from November 15 to November 17, 2023**. High school students are invited on Friday, November 17. You are welcome from 8:30 A.M. at the Nemo Science Museum, and the event launches at 9:30 A.M. (pending update)

Can I also visit the NEMO Science Museum?

Participation at DigiQuest Amsterdam also grants you free access to the NEMO Science Museum.

What exactly is the DBW23?
